**Diversity of Enrollment**

In Fall 2021 enrollment of all full-time undergraduate students in credit programs was 3647 .Of these 49% were female and 51% were male. 1% were American Indian/Alaska Native, 5% were Asian/Pacific Islander, 6% were Black, 43% were Hispanic, 35% were White, 5% were Two or More Races, and 2% were Non-Resident Alien.

**Diversity of Pell Recipients**

Federal Pell Grant recipients comprised 41% of the full-time enrolled students in Fall 2022. Of these, 56% were female and 44% were male. 75% of the Pell recipients identified themselves as members of a racial or ethnic minority.

**Retention Rates**

68.12% of the first-time, full-time undergraduate students who enrolled in Fall 2021 returned in Fall 2022. The part-time student retention rate was 42.07%.

**Graduation and Transfer Rates**

The 3-year graduation rate for full-time students entering in Fall 2019 was 13%. The 3-year transfer-out rate was 13%
