General Membership Information

Covid-19 has brought about a unique set of circumstances that have led to the creation and implementation of this application and process. Until such a time that the Covid-19 Restrictions are lifted, this application and process will stand as the primary process for the election of ASG Board Members. The ASG Board is made up of 12 seats total to include the executive board and two seats for Glendale Community College North Students. Those candidates for board membership who have met minimum qualifications and have completed and submitted an approved application to the Leadership Center may then attend two consecutive Open Business Meetings Virtually. There, his/her membership will be put to a vote after the group at large has heard a presentation by the candidate as to the merits of his/her qualifications. Please bear in mind that officer roles may be sought/secured once you have completed an entire semester (all roles other than the presidency may be voted on and filled when vacant. You are only eligible after having completed a full semester.)

Executive Officer Elections

The ASG Executive Officers are the President, Vice President, Treasurer, and Secretary. The Executive Officers shall be elected by the ASG Board. Candidates are selected from the Elected Board Members. Elections shall take place on the last meeting of the spring semester. A simple majority vote via secret ballot will determine the successful candidate. In the event of no clear winner, a runoff election of the two candidates with the greatest number of votes will occur until a simple majority is attained. The term of office shall begin immediately after commencement in the spring semester and end with the swearing in of the new ASG Officers at the end of the following spring. ASG Executive Officers may not hold concurrent Executive Officer positions with any other student Club at GCC. All Executive Officers shall be entitled to the remuneration as determined by the ASG and Maricopa County Community College District Administrative Regulations.

Please read the following:

Qualifications of Associated Student Government (ASG)

Taken from the ASG Constitution, Article IV Section II

- Carry six (6) or more credit hours at a GCC campus regardless of degree completion status
- Maintain a 2.00 GPA (4.0 = A), unless in your first semester (board member).
- Maintain a 2.50 GPA (4.0 = A), unless in your first semester (officer).
- Be available on Tuesdays at 1:30 p.m. at the main campus. There shall be a minimum of four (4) meetings (open business, executive and/or board) held each month.
- Maintain scheduled office hours.

Note:

- Students who have been removed from ASG will no longer be eligible to run for ASG.
- Students who have accumulated 100 credit hours regardless of degree completion status are ineligible for ASG.
- Tenure in any combination of ASG positions shall be limited to no more than eight (8) semesters. Tenure in any combination of officer positions shall be limited to four (4) semesters.
- All applicants must complete and submit a candidate/membership election packet and adhere to the regulations therein.
